All About Abstinence

The spring semester is finished and we have wonderful news to report! The Creating Positive Relationships (CPR) curriculum was presented to 1,501 students this past spring semester, giving us a 2016-2017 school year grand total of 3,117 students!

We are also excited to announce that our course surveys indicate that 85% of the students taught the curriculum chose abstinence and/or secondary abstinence! Additionally, we are very encouraged by the 10% increase in sexual health knowledge gained by the students through the programs teachings.

New & Exciting Things

Thirty-two Pope John Paul II Middle Schoolers participated in CPR for the first time this year. SRA Instructor, Shannon Ulrich, was also able to use CPR materials to develop a course for a religion class at St. Mary's Catholic Church.

It was a privilege to expand the CPR program to Madison County! We closed out the year with the 7th graders at Highland Middle School in Anderson. The students learned that respecting themselves and others is fundamental to making healthy choices about their sexual behavior. We are looking forward to the fall and hope to be in more of the health

classes at the second largest middle school in Indiana!

More than Just Schools

For the third summer in a row we were asked to bring our abstinence program to the young men at George Jr. Republic Boys' Home in Gas City. GJR is a residential program for boys 13-19 years of age who are seeking to change the direction of their lives after making unwise choices. SRA Instructor Neil Habegger spent five days with six young men the first week of June. One young man said he was impacted by how important it is to set healthy boundaries for his relationships. What a blessing it is to be able to make a difference in the lives of these young men!

- "I learned a lot about commitment."
- "I've learned it's ok not to do things others are doing."
- "Thank you so much for this week! I am deciding to choose abstinence! You have really helped me learn about positive relationships. I am finally realizing I am in an abusive relationship."

I am also thrilled to report that a Burris school teacher will be attending CPR training! If you are a teacher and are interested teaching the Creating Positive Relationship curriculum to your class personally, First Choice will cover the cost of your training as well as the expenses associated with bringing a substitute teacher into your classroom while you are gone.



Kayla, a senior at Ball State, was not planning on starting a family. She was looking forward to graduating with a Criminal Justice degree and starting her career. She came to us for a pregnancy test, and was shocked by the positive result. The father of the baby suggested that she consider an abortion - how could she put her life and career plans on hold for a baby? Kayla wept as we discussed her pregnancy options. She was overwhelmed and unsure of what to do. In the course of our conversation, I discovered that Kayla had placed her trust in the Lord and claimed the name of Christ. We prayed together asking God for wisdom and guidance. By the end of our time together, she had decided to parent this precious gift of life - with or without the support of the father. Praise God! After her ultrasound, we were so blessed when Kayla asked us to pray for the continued health of her baby!

But the story doesn't end there. Kayla *AND* the baby's father began attending parenting classes. They continued with the program until she moved back home after graduation. We were thrilled when she returned to Muncie a few months later to pick up the new crib and mattress set she had earned through our Parent Care program.





Kayla, reported that she had secured a great job (while still pregnant) that offered her maternity leave! What a wonderful success story! Most of all, what an amazing testimony to God's provision and grace! A woman *does not* have to choose between the life of her unborn baby and her education or career. As I sat and listened to the client, I soon discovered that she had come all the way from Anderson for our services! This was further confirmation for me that the women in the Anderson and Madison County communities are in need of the compassion and care that our ministry provides.

It was very exciting to share with this young woman, that in just a few short weeks, she will be able to come to our new Anderson location - instead of driving the nearly 20 miles it takes to get to the Muncie Center!



Additionally, last month we participated in Madison County's 3rd Annual Safety Fair at Mounds Mall. We hosted a booth filled with information about our services and examples of the types of assistance young women and families could receive through our ministry. Dozens of women requested information about First Choice! They were able to walk away knowing that in a couple of months, they would be able to come to First Choice for parenting education classes, material assistance, and so much more!

This quarter we begin a new feature in First Choice Quarterly, the *Church Spotlight*. The support of our local churches is key to our mission of sharing the love of Jesus and the truth of LIFE to the clients we see each week. In appreciation of our supporting churches, we will be highlighting a different church in each newsletter.

First up, is a church that has sacrificially supported First Choice for over 18 years, Westminster Presbyterian Church. It is located on the corner of Tillotson and Riverside Avenue, in Muncie, just one block from the Ball State University campus.

Westminster celebrated its 50th Anniversary this year. Their mission is to glorify God, enjoy Him, and make Him known. Approximately 350 members attend services on Sundays at 8:30 am, 11 am and at 6 pm.



Pastor, Kristofer Holroyd, pictured above, has been serving at the church for 10 years, with the past three years as Senior Pastor. "We are committed to preaching God's word and discipling people in the gospel of Jesus Christ," notes Pastor Holroyd. "We partner with many organizations to accomplish this goal, such as Urban Light Community Church, Muncie Mission, Blood-N-Fire, New Castle and Pendleton prisons, and of course First Choice for Women. Additionally, we support several

families serving in the mission field all over the world. We are also very passionate about reaching our college campus," Pastor Holroyd concluded.

Along with their financial support of First Choice, Westminster is also a long-time host of our Muncie location's Annual Walk for Life, one of our largest fundraising events of the year. They also provide beautiful handmade diaper bags for our new mothers.

This summer, we were honored to be the *Mission Spotlight* at their annual Vacation Bible School. We had the opportunity to visit with the children and volunteers each morning and share about the work of First Choice for Women. The group collected over 2,700 diapers that week for our ministry!



Westminster also has a number of First Choice volunteers, many who give of their time and talents on a weekly basis. One of those volunteers is Debbie Rose, pictured above, she has been with First Choice since 1988! "I first heard about First Choice, then Heart to Heart, at Westminster," Stated Debbie. "Raising my daughter as a single parent, I have been shown much kindness, friendship and generosity from my church family. Westminster has always been a church that honors life, yet also has shown compassion to post-abortive women. I have appreciated the Christ centered teaching and preaching I have received over the last 33 years, and have grown a lot in my Christian faith."

Pastor Holroyd added, "The Bible calls us to love life from the beginning, through the middle and at the end. When we care for the mothers in our community that is the best way to promote life and to oppose abortion. If we are not committed to these families, we are not committed to life."
