Empowering Confident Fathers

Recently, a young man came with his girlfriend for a pregnancy test. They are planning to parent, but he was scared. After meeting with one of our male volunteers, he said, "I already feel so much better." Confident, involved fathers will lead to more stable families and better outcomes for their children.

Men, during this season of change, could God be speaking to you about becoming involved in our Fatherhood Initiative? Is this *your* season to make a difference for LIFE in Delaware and Madison counties? We cannot meet the needs of these young men without YOU! Voice for the Voiceless

In the pro-life movement, we often speak of being a "voice for the voiceless" in reference to advocating for the unborn. Yet sometimes, it's our clients who have lost their voice. Between childhood trauma and unfortunate situations they have placed themselves in, they lose the confidence to speak up for themselves.

Don't you love helping young women get their voices back? I know I do. I see myself in so many of the young ladies that come into our office.

Eighteen-year-old "Callie" nervously twirled her hair and glanced up at me. Her voice was soft and hesitant, as though she were afraid of coming up with the wrong answer to what we were talking about.

"I don't know what to do," she said. "My parents told me if I ever got pregnant, they would cut off my college money. When I told my boyfriend that I might be pregnant, he told me I'd better have an abortion, or else we are done."

Callie's best friend had come with her to the pregnancy test appointment. When Callie's test result showed positive, her girlfriend cried out, "You'd better not get an abortion!" I watched as Callie's face displayed complete sadness, hopelessness, and despair. I asked permission to touch her hand and she said I could. I just told her that I was once her and I wanted to share my story with her. She allowed me to do so as tears ran down her cheeks.

It was evident to me that Callie lacked confidence and was stuck in a pattern of allowing others to do her decision-making for her. Now she faced a dilemma.

She had a major decision to make, and the significant voices in her life were conflicting with each other. Can you imagine being torn between mom, dad, grandma, best friends, and the father of the baby? That is too much for any woman to face. This is why they become numb and voiceless.

She was standing at the crossroads – without a voice.

The good news is, Callie was in a safe place. We shared accurate information with her without telling her what to do. We offered her emotional support without judgment. We let her use her own voice to process what she was thinking and feeling. This is what First Choice for Women is all about - a safe place for families to come to seek help, hope, and compassion.

With our support, Callie was able to make the courageous decision to keep her baby.

Callie had been terrified of her mother's disapproval, yet her mom quickly became a doting grandmother. And though Callie and her boyfriend broke up, he stepped up to get involved in his little one's life and help in any way he could.

"You guys didn't push me," Callie shared with me later. "Everybody else was pushing me and telling me what I should do. You let me make up my own mind."

We saw Callie for Parent Care lessons every week after her ultrasound appointment. She soon became a strong, confident woman and mom to a beautiful little baby. She also continued her college education – the funds did not get cut off – and she came by to interview me for an essay she was writing.

The young woman I saw before me was not the same girl I had spoken with months prior. She smiled and spoke with such grace. She shone with a confidence she had lacked before.

Callie had made a good choice. In the process, she'd found her voice.

As we speak up for the tiny, vulnerable unborn, how wonderful that we also get to come alongside their parents as well. When we help parents speak out of the deepest place of their nurturing hearts, we have the privilege of participating in a double blessing.

By refusing to push an agenda, we help both mother and child find their voice.

CHURCH SPOTLIGHT

Grace Baptist

Grace Baptist Church, Anderson, IN, was founded in May of 1958. Pastor Paul Vincent, along with thirteen other charter members, organized the church and wrote the doctrinal statement. At the time the Articles of Incorporation were filed, the church was meeting in a storefront property on Brown Street. The church later bought the property located at 432 W 300 N. Pastor Don Camp led in the ground-breaking ceremony. Daniel

Stevens has been the senior pastor for nearly five years. These have been years of great spiritual growth, along



with a major remodel in the property to improve the appearance and function of our facilities. First Choice for Women has a strong advocate at Grace in Will DuBois. He has been a church member for almost twenty years, and a deacon much of that time. He became part of the church staff in 2019 and heads up the outreach program at Grace.

The church's largest ministry is Indiana Christian Academy, with approximately 275 students in K3-12th grade. They also run the Madison County Fire Rescue House, serving displaced individuals with housing needs. They have Life Group Bible Studies for all ages, and Precept Bible Studies. They have children's ministries, including nurseries, Kidstown, and AWANA. Their teen ministry is called Ignite Youth, and their young adults ministry is called Generation 4:12. Keenagers is their seniors ministry that meets weekly for faith, fellowship and food. They have a ministry called Sew & Share which donates homemade receiving blankets, lap quilts, and similar projects to several organizations in the community, including First Choice for Women. They have a Hispanic ministry with services in Spanish and provide an English as a Second Language (ESL) class. Their main preaching and teaching services are on Sunday at 10:30 am and 6:00 pm and Wednesday at 7:00 pm. Annually, they host Food Trucks and Friends Day and Harvest Family Night in the fall, as well as other special days for outreach to the community. They have a BRICK Ministry to help with the remodel and repair area of property. They also sponsor Love Works activities in support of other area ministries and service organizations. They regularly support over forty missionaries and ministries at home and around the world.

"At Grace, Jesus is the reason we are here. We want to show you how much He means to us by the way we love each other, worship together and proclaim Him in our preaching. Grace is a family-friendly church that believes the Bible is God's Word and embraces the call to make disciples. We aren't a perfect church, but we do possess a genuine passion for God's Word and for people," states the staff at Grace Baptist.

"We are thankful to be able to support a ministry that not only supports lives of children who don't yet have the ability to defend themselves, but actually supports the women and families through their situations - helping find solutions for the struggles they are facing and pointing them to the gospel of Christ to find the ultimate solution in all of life!"

"We fully support FCW's mission of meeting both the physical and spiritual needs of moms in our community. We support life, and we also want to help moms in the community. In addition to being regular sponsors and supporters of the Walk for Life and the Annual Banquet, we have started regular monthly support of First Choice for Women this year to provide needed resources for regular operations. Our fervent hope and prayer is that every church who believes in life would do the same."

Grace Baptist is a loving, caring church that desires to contribute to the community. It is a welcoming place, accepting of people who are struggling with life issues. It is a place where the broken can come to be healed, that preaches the gospel of Christ. and stands by the Word of God unashamedly.

Pastor Stevens is very careful to preach God's Word and not his own opinion. The preaching from the pulpit at GBC is the preaching of God's Word! The focus is on the Word and will of God. The congregation loves Him, and they love people. Pastor Stevens faithfully preaches and teaches the Bible and welcomes all people, as they are, to come and hear - and be transformed by - God's Word.
